IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. No later than Tuesday, November 24, 2009, defendants Freeland Systems, LLC and John Freeland (collectively "Freeland") shall provide plaintiffs a written list specifying the following:

- a. Each piece of property that Freeland proposes to sell to satisfy its security interest.
- b. As to each piece of property:
 - i. Why that property constitutes collateral within the meaning of the Asset Purchase Agreement.
 - ii. How that property came to be within Freeland's possession.
 - iii. Witnesses who have knowledge relevant to the property, why that property constitutes collateral, and how that property came to be within Freeland's possession.
2. No later than 12:00 p.m. on Monday, November 30, 2009, plaintiffs must file a letter with the Court stating how much time they need for discovery relating to the property claimed as collateral in Freeland's list.
3. No later than 12:00 p.m. on Tuesday, December 1, 2009, Freeland must file a response to plaintiffs' letter.
4. The Court will then promptly issue a scheduling order setting deadlines for discovery and for any motion regarding the alleged collateral that plaintiffs may wish to bring.
5. Plaintiffs' motion for a temporary restraining order [Docket No. 22] is DENIED AS MOOT.
